Please pray for our current Members of the US Supreme Court. They hold the life or death of tens of millions of unborn babies in their hands, and their collective rulings affect each and every person in America.



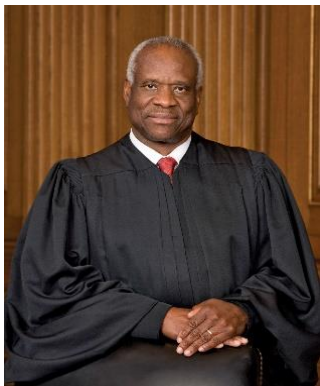
John G. Roberts, Jr., Chief Justice of the United States

Born: Buffalo, New York on January 27, 1955 (age 65)

Nominated by: President George W. Bush

Took Seat on the Court: September 29, 2005

Married to his wife Jane Marie Sullivan in 1996, the couple have two children, Josephine and Jack. Until the summer of 2020, John had sided with pro-life advocates in his rulings. Most recently, he has aligned with pro-abortion advocates.



Clarence Thomas, Associate Justice

Born: Pinpoint community near Savannah, Georgia on June 23, 1948 (age 72)

Nominated by: President George H. W. Bush

Took Seat on the Court: October 23, 1991

On May 30, 1987, Clarence married his wife Virginia Lamp. His only child, Jamal Adeen, was from a previous marriage. Clarence has sided with pro-life advocates in his rulings.



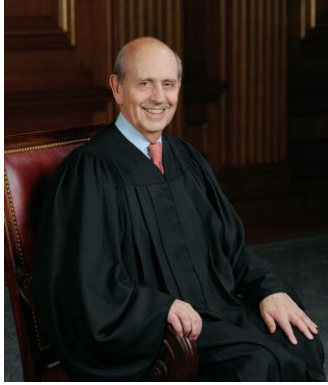
Amy Coney Barrett, Associate Justice

Born: New Orleans, Louisiana on January 28, 1972 (age 48)

Nominated by: President Donald Trump

Took Seat on the Court: October 26, 2020

In 1999, Amy married fellow Notre Dame Law School graduate, Jess M. Barrett. Amy and her husband have seven children, two were adopted from Haiti. Amy has sided with pro-life advocates in past Appellate Court rulings.



Stephen G. Breyer, Associate Justice

Born: San Francisco, California on August 15, 1938 (age 82)

Nominated by: President Bill Clinton

Took Seat on the Court: August 3, 1994

In 1967, Stephen married Joanna Hare and together they have three children—Chloe, Nell, and Michael. He has sided with pro-abortion advocates in his rulings.



Samuel A. Alito, Jr., Associate Justice

Born: Trenton, New Jersey on April 1, 1950 (age 70)

Nominated by: President George W. Bush

Took Seat on the Court: January 31, 2006

Married to Martha-Ann Bomgardner in 1985, the couple have two children—Philip and Laura. Samuel has sided with pro-life advocates in his rulings.



Sonia Sotomayor, Associate Justice

Born: Bronx, New York on April 1, 1950 (age 66)

Nominated by: President Barack Obama

Took Seat on the Court: May 26, 2009

Sonia is unmarried and has sided with pro-abortion advocates in her rulings.



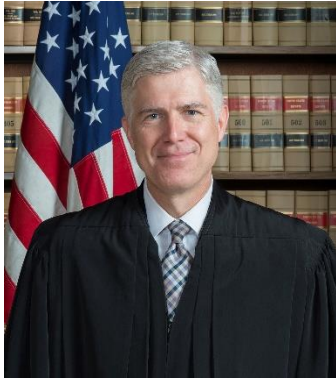
Elena Kagan, Associate Justice

Born: New York, New York on April 28, 1960 (age 60)

Nominated by: President Barack Obama, originally as the Solicitor General of the United States, she was then nominated by the President to Associate Justice, later that year.

Took Seat on the Court: August 7, 2010

Elena is unmarried and has sided with pro-abortion advocates in her rulings.



Neil M. Gorsuch, Associate Justice

Born: Denver, Colorado on August 29, 1967 (age 53)

Nominated by: President Donald J. Trump

Took Seat on the Court: April 10, 2017

Neil is married to his wife Louise and they have two daughters. He has sided with pro-life advocates in his rulings.



Brett M. Kavanaugh, Associate Justice

Born: Washington, D.C., on February 12, 1965 (age 55)

Nominated by: President Donald J. Trump

Took Seat on the Court: October 6, 2018

Brett married Ashley Estes in 2004 and together they have two daughters, Margaret and Liza. Brett has sided with pro-life advocates in his rulings.
